Final acceptance will be based on high school graduation and having met the program specific requirements.

ENGINEERING & NURSING REQUIREMENTS

Engineering Certificate:

Successful completion of this program ensures that students who transfer to an engineering degree program at another institution in British Columbia typically require only three additional years of study to complete their degree.

English language requirements

English is the language of instruction at CapU. All applicants are required to demonstrate competence in the English language prior to admission.

If English is not your first language or you've received your education in a language other than English, you must meet our English Language Requirements.

Students with less than 67% in English Studies 12 or English 12 or English First Peoples 12 will be required to write the <u>Capilano University English Diagnostic Test (EDT)</u> prior to registering in an English course. Admission is competitive, so meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.

Engineering Transition Diploma:

Capilano University's Engineering Transition Diploma program provides mature students a pathway to obtain an applied science degree, en route to becoming professional engineers.

The program also caters to recent high school graduates who lack the pre-requisites for entry into a traditional engineering program.

Successful completion of this program ensures that students who transfer to an engineering degree program at another institution in British Columbia typically require only three additional years of study to complete their degree.

Basic requirements

- High school graduation
- Successful completion of English Language Arts 30-1
- A minimum grade of C+ in Mathematics 30-1 or
 - o A minimum grade of A in Mathematics 20-1 or
 - o A minimum grade of C- in MATH 097 or
 - o A minimum grade of B in BMTH 044 or
 - Math Placement Test (Pre-Calculus MPT or Calculus MPT)
- Successful completion of Chemistry 20 or
 - o BCHM 044

Students with less than 67% in English Studies 12 or English 12 or English First Peoples 12 will be required to write the <u>Capilano University English Diagnostic Test (EDT)</u> prior to registering in an English course. Admission into the Engineering Transition program is competitive, so meeting the above minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.

Nursing – Not Applicable
