Awarded based on academic excellence, to students who are in the top 5% of the competitive admission average for each first-entry undergraduate degree program. No Application required for Dean's International Award Program. Awarded on the basis of academic achievement to international students enter first year of any first-entry degree program in the Faculty of Arts and science, Stephen J.R. Smith School of Engineering and Applied Science, Smith School of Business, or Faculty of Health Sciences.

NEW INSTITUTION UPDATES/HIGHLIGHTS

- New Program! Concurrent Education/Kinesiology: In September 2024, we will have a new direct entry ConEd/Kinesiology program. Available for the Intermediate/Senior teaching level only; teaching subjects will be Health and Physical Education in combination with one additional teachable subject either Biology, Chemistry, Geography or Math.
- <u>Commitment Scholars:</u> The Commitment Scholars Award celebrates and recognizes demonstrated leadership in, and commitment to, racial justice, social justice, or diversity initiatives by a student in their high school or in their community. Ten Awards each valued at \$48,000 over 4 years. Eligible candidates includes individuals who self-identify on the application as a member of an underserved or underrepresented group, including Black, Indigenous and other racialized students, persons with disabilities, and LGBTQ2S+. *Application deadline is February 15th*, 2024.
- <u>International Admission Awards:</u> Awards of up to \$100,000 over 4 years are available for first year internationals students entering their Queen's Undergraduate degree program on a study permit. International students may also be eligible for Queen's Principle's Scholarships

- English 30-1 with minimum grade of 75%, Biology 30, Chemistry 30, one of Mathematics 30-1, 30-2, or 31, plus one additional academic 30 or 31 level course.
